



Boudoir Photography – Frequently Asked Questions

When considering a Boudoir Session, most women have a lot of questions. Here are some responses to help with that. Please feel free to contact me with any additional questions you may have.

I'd like to do this, but I'm SOOOOO nervous!

Honestly, who wouldn't be? We spend our lives covering ourselves up for the public. It is more than reasonable that you would feel apprehensive. Rest assured, I will do everything in my power to make you feel more comfortable about the situation. We will listen to music, talk and laugh. If at anytime during the session we need to take a break or change something up, we will.

Can I drink during the session?

It's actually recommended. Anything that will help you loosen up is fine by me. When choosing your beverage, think about the look of it. We may end up using it in some of the photos. For non-drinkers out there, I recommend picking up a box of chocolates, fruit or some other tasty treat.

How bare do I have to become during the session?

Only as bare as you feel comfortable. Sometimes the sexiest images aren't about what you show, but what you don't show. An oversized shirt that belongs to your man, a jersey from your favorite team or a blouse lightly open, are just a few examples of sexy attire that shows very little.

Do you pose me? What can I expect?

There is some posing involved in these kinds of sessions. However, I try to make it as easy on you as possible. Most of the time I will show you what I have in mind, and we will go from there. During the session I may ask if I can adjust your hair or clothing. I respect your personal space; so if you'd rather adjust things on your own, just let me know.

Where do the sessions take place?

This is really up to you. Some clients prefer to book a hotel room for their shoot, while others prefer to do it in their home. The key is to find a location where you will feel comfortable.



How many outfits should I bring?

In a two-hour block I can usually accommodate up to three outfit changes. We generally start with the least revealing to help you ease into the session. I also like to remind you that you should incorporate accessories. Heels, hose, jewelry, hats and ties are always welcome.

Will you make me look thinner?

You are who you are, and that is beautiful. Do not worry about such things. That being said, it is my job to find the most flattering angles of my subjects. I want every woman I photograph to walk away looking and feeling their best.

I don't like this about my body...Can you fix it?

Again, don't concern yourself about any imperfections. The truth of the matter is every woman has something they would like to change. I appreciate you telling me about these things up front so that I can keep an eye on them, but honestly some of our imperfections are what make us the most beautiful.

Will you touch up my skin?

It seems like right before picture day, an unwanted blemish appears out of nowhere. If you would like me to touch up something like that, just let me know.

Will anyone be able to see my session?

Your final images are posted in a private gallery. They are password protected. You may share the login information with anyone you choose. I never post the names of my boudoir clients. Everyone is referred to with an alias.

Will any of my pictures be posted on the website?

They may. Before I photograph any session, I require a model release. This release will allow me to use the photographs for business purposes. The images I post are tasteful and represent the most beautiful portrayal of my clients. If you are concerned about this, please discuss it with me before booking.



I'm planning a surprise; can you hold off on posting the images publically?

Absolutely. I love surprises, and I get as excited as my clients when they choose to do this.

Can I incorporate other people into my session?

Sometimes people are more comfortable with their significant other or their friends. Additional people may be brought into the session, but they will also need to pay a sitting fee. Sessions must remain tasteful. Please inquire for more information.

Can I have my cat or dog in some of the pictures?

As long as your pets are kind and current on their vaccinations, they may be included in the session. No additional fee applies.
